
Warm Wishes for a Happy Retirement


We would like to extend our gratitude for the expertise and guidance provided by these two board members and wish them the very best in their upcoming summer retirement.

A Message from Stan Cameron

During my volunteer orientation eight years ago, I recall our trainer Rami Shami saying on more than one occasion,



I recall not being able to fully understand the impact of this statement. Eight years later, as a Resident Support Worker, volunteer, and donor, I completely understand what he meant.

Although I can share many stories, here is a recent one that comes to mind:

I reported for my Sunday shift and immediately sensed something was happening in the residence. I quickly looked at the candle on the hallway stand to see if it was lit which means a resident has passed.



The wife of the resident asked Nurse Tiffany if someone could read Psalm 23 at the leaving ceremony (a beautiful way of acknowledging the passing of a resident). Tiffany told her there was a volunteer on duty who each year reads over 400 names of loved ones being remembered as part of the Light & Love celebration. Would it be OK to ask him to read the Psalm? When Tiffany asked if I could do the reading I agreed immediately. There were many visitors, staff and volunteers present when the time came. The family was effusive in their appreciation for everything Bethell Hospice had offered them.

The single most common comment I hear from residents and their families is,

66 Thank you to Bethell Hospice for the peace and the peacefulness that you have brought to our family.

Every time I went to Bethell Hospice there was a smiling face to greet me and a conversation about how I was feeling. This meant more to me than anyone will ever know. Each and every staff member was always available to us no matter what the time of day or night. Although I cannot name all the nurses and PSWs who cared for Lucy, they were all truly angels as they quietly came in to Lucy's room and checked on her. It provided me with a sense of comfort and calm at a very difficult time in our lives. Special thanks to Tiffany who was there with us at the end of my sweet sister's life.

Caring for someone who is dying is truly a gift. It is a gift that can be very hard on some days, but most importantly it is a gift of love and compassion for the person who we so dearly loved. Each and every staff member at Bethell truly believes this. They provide support to our loved ones and our families unconditionally.

We are extremely grateful for the support we received from Bethell Hospice. It felt like home to me some days and made me stronger knowing that someone was there for Lucy.

My gratitude and thanks have no limits when I think of Bethell Hospice and all of its amazing staff and volunteers.
