Unlike many other local charities, Bethell Hospice depends on the generosity of donors simply to remain in operation.

Government funding covers only direct care medical staffing costs – about 60% of the cost to operate Bethell Hospice. Every other cost – from food, medication and the residential hospice building itself to community, bereavement and outreach programs – is funded directly from donations.

To keep our doors open, Bethell Hospice Foundation must raise over \$1,000,000 each year.

Hospice services are an essential component of the health care system, focussing on individualized care and comfort, when a cure is not possible. Our professional medical team provides relief from pain, prioritizing attentive care and fostering close personal relationships, all in a beautiful, tranquil environment.

Hospice care is both highly valued by our community, and cost effective (\$500 per day, as compared with \$1100 per day in hospital).
